"T" represents the tubular shape of the lamp. The number following "T" usually represents the diameter of the lamp in eighths of an inch. T8 lamps have a diameter of 8/8", or 1". T5 lamps are 5/8" in diameter.

Program Offer: The Program covers products purchased and/or services rendered on or after **January 1, 2006**.

Program Requirements:

1. CFL lamp and fixtures must be Energy Star (ES) labeled.
2. Fluorescent tube lamp fixtures must be type T8 or T5 with electronic ballasts.
3. A copy of sales invoice must be provided to the Cooperative
4. The lighting load must be served the Cooperative providing the incentive.
5. Agricultural lighting applications must be rated for the intended purpose (See below)

Energy Star Verification:

Energy Star qualification for Commercial customers can be verified by one of the following:

1. Customer provides cutout of package showing Energy Star logo, product type and model.
2. Customer provides cutout of UPC symbol and model number from product package.
3. Customer provide model number of product and qualification will be verified by the Cooperative. Energy Star listings can be found at:

Agricultural Requirements

1. Special cold-start ballasts are needed for fluorescent lights used in buildings such as machine sheds, free-stall dairy barns and swine growing/finishing buildings.
2. Heat Lamp Sockets - Use porcelain sockets for all lamps designed to produce heat. Fixtures made of rubber and plastic are not acceptable.
3. For livestock buildings:
 - use dust and moisture tight nonmetallic fixtures with shatterproof, vapor tight globes.
 - Select fluorescent light fixtures made of corrosion-resistant materials with gasketed covers.
 - Fixtures with fiberglass or aluminum enclosures and Lexan® covers are recommended. Do not use fixtures made of ABS plastic and with acrylic diffusers in buildings where chemicals and high pressure hot water cleaning and sanitizing systems are used.

Application and Eligibility Process: The Cooperative reserves the right to verify sales transactions and to have reasonable access to Participating Customer's facility to inspect both pre-existing energy efficient product or equipment (if applicable) and the Energy-Efficient Measures installed under this Program, either prior to issuing incentives or at a later time.

To be eligible for Program Incentives, invoices itemizing the Energy-Efficient Measures must accompany each Program application form. Each invoice must include specific customer information, including, but not limited to the type, size, make and model, serial number and date of purchase of Energy-Efficient Measures. An authorized representative of the Participating Customer must sign, date, and submit the completed application

along with the invoice, and the manufacturer's equipment performance sheet.

Energy-Efficient Measures must be installed in buildings served by the Cooperative as designated on the Customer's rebate application. The Customer must ultimately own the equipment, either through an up-front purchase or at the end of a short-term lease.

Equipment procured by Participating Customers through another program offered by the Cooperative, as applicable, is not eligible for rebate through this Program.

Rebate Amount: Program Incentives will equal either: a) the approved Program Incentive amount, or b) 50% of the actual cost of the Energy-Efficient Measure, or c) the maximum rebate of \$2000, whichever is less, as determined by the Cooperative. If information is missing or incorrect on the application, processing and delivery of the incentive may take longer.

Warranty Information: Your cooperative makes no warranties, expressed or implied, with respect to equipment operation, material, workmanship or manufacturing. The Cooperative does not guarantee that a certain level of energy or cost savings will result from the use of products covered by this program.

Tax Liability: The Cooperative will not be responsible for any tax liability that may be imposed on the Participating Customer as a result of the payment of Program Incentives.

Limitation of Liability: Participating Customers agree that the Cooperative's liability, in connection with this Program, is limited to paying the Program Incentive specified (when all Terms and Conditions have been satisfied by the customer). Under no circumstances shall the Cooperative be liable for any consequential or incidental damages resulting from participation in this Program.

Participating Customer's Certification: Participating Customer certifies that he/she purchased and installed the equipment listed in their application at their defined location served by the Cooperative. Participating Customer agrees that all information is true and that he/she has conformed to all of the program and equipment requirements listed in the application.

Program Changes/Termination: While this rebate program will be in effect for an indefinite period, the Cooperative reserves the right to extend, modify (this includes incentive levels) or terminate this Program without prior or further notice. Typically a 60 day notice will be made in the event that any program is terminated. The customer is responsible for checking with the Cooperative to determine whether the program has been changed or is still in effect.

Other Program Rules

The cooperative reserves the right to inspect installations before issuing the rebate. If the application does not comply with the cooperative's rules and qualifications, the rebate amount may be adjusted.

Customers must apply for rebates within one year of the purchase date (as shown on the customer's invoice).
